Learn how to cultivate log-grown shiitake mushrooms in this hands-on workshop, and take home an inoculated log to get you started! We will also learn methods for outdoor cultivation of oyster, lion's mane, king stropharia, shaggy mane and elm oyster mushrooms, and will install a king stropharia bed on site in an evolving permaculture demonstration project. Though the wild mushroom season will just be starting, we will go on a short guided foray and will learn about the safest and most delicious local species. If we're lucky, we might even find a delectable morel!
